around the Woodyard Gordon

Named Cameron Island 25<sup>th</sup> Nov 896  
Windy some snow no Lights in  
the Lighthouse to night 30<sup>th</sup>  
St Andrews Day The  
Festival of the Scotch Fine  
Randolph here to Day working  
at the Stable no Boats to Day  
Gordon crossed took the Boe  
of Ducks to Haggarty to take  
out to Summerstown Station  
1<sup>st</sup> December Frosty 7 one  
W Wind cutting and Sawing wood  
in the upper field Gordon went  
to work at Henketh McDonald  
no Boats to Day 2<sup>nd</sup> Fine Day set  
some fires in the Marsh Fernandez  
went to a Fraser cutting British  
Ice Froze in the Rushes hustling com  
3<sup>rd</sup> Fine Windy cutting alders and 3 or 4  
Set fires in the Marsh Back North  
Shot 2 Ducks 4<sup>th</sup> Cutting 13 rick  
Fine Windy snowed to night seen  
a crane.
