- 12. Pigeon & Macdonald in bush cutting long wood
- 13. Stormy day men not in bush
- 14. Men in bush Jimmie drawing the wood Hugh McKenzie son of D. H McKenzie died in St Michael Hospital was buried here ^{St Marys cemetery} paid Macdonald 1.00 cash, Jimmie paid Pigeon 1.00 cash I wrote to Sandy this week, and to Mrs Blacklock
- 15. The boys drew five loads of wood and some hay Mrs Ellis by 81.00 % Pan bread 20, add % bush potatoes
- 16. Sunday St. Patrick's day. dull in morning about noon got fine and bright I did not go to church rent 15.00 for offer
- 17. Fine mild day. Had the two men finished the wood and cut a few Cider logs. 15 I think. Paid M Donald and gave him credit for 1 month's rent for 30, & for day 25. to 4 loaves 20 Muddy some cheese J. P. and Birdie and Agnes down for a while
- 18. Windy day and snow. The village hockey team went to ~~Marrioburg~~ to play Lancaster for the brag for championship of the league Muddy went
- 19. Our club won 5 to 1 against Lancaster. A number went to meet the boys at Lancaster, and gave them a good reception. Birdie and Mrs Grant in for a short time % 25-lb flour at the mill 10

- 20. Thursday. Fine bright day, our folk are drawing a few logs to the saw mill. % butter 50, 4 loaves 20 Jimmie finished paying Pigeon 1.50, 60 yards day = 2, and 2 before M Donald got credit 2.50, 1st from Mrs. 1.50 from Jimmie 5th in all. See Page 294 - % 1 gall lard oil
- 21. Very fine mild day the creek is almost even with the side walk. The village gave a banquet to the hockey team last night and a good time is reported Mrs Donald Grant (carpenter) was buried in forenoon, Robert Robertson was buried in afternoon
- 22. Dull Mrs Ellis paid 1st
- 23. Ugly day. wind from east, snow falling ugly all day. very few in church
- 24. Fine bright day. Jimmie went in forenoon to Peter Muir Grants for pressed hay, 2 ton 24.00 % 2 loaves 10. Cream tartar 10 = Jimmie is putting out manure
- 25. Put out 8 loads manure
- 26. Fine day men worked in morning. % 2 loaves 10 1/2 lb Blue Ribbon tea 25. A little child of McEllongale buried here today. ~~she was buried with a~~ ~~partly off~~
- 27. Sent a letter to Sandy. 1.50 Marion. % butter 90 ^{1st fine} % 4 loaves. Bot a ham from John Frame 12 lbs 12.00 for 16 1.45
- 28. Yesterday the water in our creek was higher than I ever saw it - it was running over the two bridges, and the roofing of the one on Johnston road floated off
- 29. Very fine day. 2 loaves 10
- 30. Fine day. I did not go to church
