- 9 Rain today. 7/4 lb tea 20. 1 gall local oil 20. 2 loaves 10. 1 lb soda biscuit 10. 3 lbs butter from Feston.

- 11 Thursday Murdy went to pump creek.
- 12 Another fine day. Murdy got home at 6 P.M.
- 13 Fine day. 7/25 lbs flour 80¢. Soap 10. Cheese 28. oat meal 7. Bread 10. 45
- 14 Sunday off 24¢. 25
- 15 I made a large white washing.
- 16 Mr. Thurson sent pay for the logs. \$54.46.
- 17 Ann Hall 1/2 day 30.
- 18 Bread 15. macaroni 10. Paid Murdy 51.25.
- 19 Cheese 23. 23
- 20 Birdie and Agnes down. Birdie is getting a dress made by Mrs Larogue. Baked in fore noon. pie & cake. In afternoon Mrs John McGillis and Mrs Corral of Michigan (one Annie McKel family of Black River West of Williamstown) called for about 1/2 hour. In the evening Mrs Owen, Josie Dixon, and grandson Bert Norris, came to tea. 7/2 loaves by Murdy 18. Incl 3 by John 36.
- 21 Fine day. not very many in church. Had no person for dinner. Mr Mrs Govin and Mrs W. Robertson called after prayer meeting.
- 22 Fine bright day.
- 23 I took some green corn to Mrs Campbell and Govin. Mrs Govin sent me a beef dumplin and some potatoes for my dinner. I ate too much. 7/2 potatoes 5.
- 24 Done some hoeing in garden.
- 25 Birdie called. he was down to a dress maker Donald MacMaster and his son Donald called for a few minutes. 7/4 lb tea 20. molasses 20. 5 bars soap 15. 55. fly paper 10. cream tartar 15. 1 kg rubber rings 33. coarse salt 10. 54-52.
