Wed May 4th. large crowd there.

Weather - Colder & cloudy.  
men worked in garden a.m. D Brown worked on summer follow, Pat  
planted tatty onions in p.m. we cleaned down stair hall, Mr Mills here  
just after dinner, later Jean & Gurbis, had a B.D. Mrs Brooke & her sister

Thurs May 5th  
Weather - Cloudy, cool East wind.  
Pat set out 10 new rhubarb roots in a.m. & planted lettuce & radish

Weather - Cloudy a.m. & showery all afternoon & even-

over apples & washed eggs, Della attended coach class 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.  
at church, went to Victoria Square dance at night. J. Smith store  
produce, 12 pts cream, 10 bags potatoes, 2 bus apples eggs. D & Jg Store  
& Jg to a mantle set, 39 Jg eggs to A Brown to hatch for us, also 50 Jersey giant  
eggs from Protons to set. 115 Jg eggs

Sat May 7  
Weather - cloudy & showery most of day.

Douglas went to market, called at his mother's. Billy came home with  
him, he & Marion went to Unionville at night for empty egg crates.  
called at Di's also at Ada's H, but she was not home, still no luck.  
men cleaned LaCluses seed oats, Della & Lore left for home at 9 p.m. Pat & M  
Sun May 8 Mother's Day home by 9-20. Norm Sharon

Weather - Cloudy & showery.  
Norm did not come back. men here had to separate milk, Douglas  
Marion left at 130 p.m. & went down to his mother's returning  
about 5 p.m. I alone all afternoon, spend evening by fireside.  
one gosling hatched.

Mon May 9  
Weather - cloudy & light showers.  
men drew manure with Bessie & Dick in a.m. Pat set out 70  
berrie canes. we cleaned kitchen. they pruned some trees p.m.
