here to tell us about Jo being
Dead and wanting us to go
over to morrow to Milk
their cows and feed their pig
and Mume to Douquetts 21st of
Brought Tea at Haggart

potatoes Bought 8 lb of nails 14th very fine
making the Rafters and putting them
on Broke Down the Storehouse for
to get the Boards of it to put
on to the other The Rocket began
going Down the same Day she
comes up Took up the Corn to the
House Ploughed a Little Piling the
stumps in the Back Peice John H
crossed to Hamiltons I Spunk came down
with him and took him Back 15th
fine at the Granery Boarding it Draw
nails Arthur Craig here Dave Catterach
