Mon Oct 12<sup>th</sup> cloudy most of the day and cool I sawd Split and carried wood in the Shop part of the day.

Tue Oct 13<sup>th</sup> clear and warm a heavy fog this morning. I was setting in the house

Wed Oct 14<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was sawing and splitting some slabs for stove wood Ella was here this after noon picking

Thu Oct 15<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate there was a light shower this fore noon I have been setting in the house all day Charle called a few minutes

Fri Oct 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. Rose was here cleaning house. Sarah away to Petrolia she went there a week ago last wednesday

Sat Oct 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. Bilton called this morning. James Clark came over and got a few apples. not doing much myself

Sun Oct 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold

Mon Oct 19<sup>th</sup> cloudy fore part cloudy latter part of the day wind from South West and cool

Tue Oct 20<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was looking over some of my old English letters most of those they speak of are gone the way we all shall soon go

Wed Oct 21<sup>st</sup> clear and warm a pleasant day. there was a man here selling Specks I got mine changed. Sarah not back yet

Thu Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> clear warm and windy. I was shelling corn part of the day.

Fri Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> cloudy and cold. Sarah was here baking & cleaning house and making Saur kraut. Walter and Ella was gathering apples. it is dipping snow

Sat Oct 24<sup>th</sup> clear and cold a sprinkle of snow on the ground this morning

Sun Oct 25<sup>th</sup> clear and cold

Mon Oct 26<sup>th</sup> cloudy wind from North West and cold. I was trying to keep the stove warm
