In burns of the conjunctiva and cornea from lime or hot metal, no occlusive dressing should be applied. The eye should be filled with sterile vaseline and left open, the eyeballs and lids being moved frequently to prevent adhesions which would be sure to follow if the eye was bandaged.—J. A.
