for dinner, I clipped eight sheep in morning they went to town, got seeds, <sup>2.00</sup> at Hewers, 2<sup>00</sup> 2 60

paid 15<sup>00</sup> an ac, paid 15 00

for Simpson \$4<sup>52</sup> 4 52

Wm. Nichel \$3<sup>75</sup> 3 75

paid \$10 on D<sup>r</sup> Savage ac 10 00

Candies 10¢ 10

paid Jas Friendship 3<sup>40</sup> 3 40

Father and Geo cut Rye out of wheat in afternoon and. Children & I spudded bars in bush.

got twelve pounds of wheat from Hales
