Mr James Cameron (land) Sr  
Took up his Rigging from his Tent took up his  
Bun & 4 Naves and Bohemian went down  
together stormy to night Drove some Drags  
from the Lower Point seen a Big White Owl  
on the Lower Point got a Hat & Cap snow on  
the mountains Feeding the Milk cow and the calf  
and calved the Dick away for 2 Day but came  
back to the shore 23<sup>rd</sup> Stormy Snowing South Wind  
Died on this Day of the North Dock Master  
Departed 28<sup>th</sup> 1870. 24<sup>th</sup> Snowing the Croquet saw Windy  
22<sup>nd</sup> Went to look for the Sheep color Windy  
Bottle on the West March hay stack Feeding  
the corn a lb on the stable top 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday 6 Bow  
a ground the 2 or 3 I was Below Mr Halls Light  
one of the Kingston lumber Steamer a Pitt pelter  
coming up gave her a berth and left her think  
its the Kendrick that came down and took her  
off stormy South West Wind snow Big flakes  
of Frank and Bohemian went down  
the Sparrow did not come out since the 20<sup>th</sup>

24<sup>th</sup> Chopping and Sawing Wood 25<sup>th</sup> Wood  
Tying the Peasens in the shed 26<sup>th</sup> Stormy snowing  
cutting and Sawing Wood on the Pitt Pelter  
27<sup>th</sup> Using a Door on the Big shed put some  
Cold some 28<sup>th</sup> a fine morning cropped some  
of Mr Ward's lb Tea 28 cents & Soda 5 cents Sled up  
oil Bought 9 lb Summers bread 10 Pins Pipe  
Received for in 1 Renshaw Dollar for  
a New look stick The Wind raised stop at  
Mr Hamiltons The Kendrick went down  
with a Barge to Valoy field carry's Hamilton  
and woman's Abrams Wood Sacramento on  
the front Mr Mrs Nish from Cornwall  
29<sup>th</sup> at Hamiltons Parish a Bee Ploughing  
the last Day for cattle to go into the States  
30<sup>th</sup> Sunday St Andrews 31<sup>st</sup> Came home  
Hamiltons a Board at Renshaw's wharf  
night continued

Mr James Cameron (land) Sr 30<sup>th</sup> 1875  
Prolight in the Halls Lighthouse to night the other  
2 Lights of Johnstons lit up brought Cold and Heavy  
St Andrews Day 1<sup>st</sup> December setting the  
Marshes a Fire Light on 4 haly's left and Cherry Island  
Left in Blag small part of the Day as we think of Keller  
her Tomorrow 2 Killed Beary Light on Cherry Island  
3<sup>rd</sup> Cutting up the Bag and pulling it East Wind  
Kind snow cold and fine Drove up the old down  
Barn in the grave Drove some Long Pieces at the  
Door and East of the Stable 5 all the Day 6<sup>th</sup>  
On the Beach the Commenced the best load of fine  
Hay Tim Hopkins there and one of Pauls Bay  
Cutting and sawing Wood East Wind cold Lots of  
Ducks & 1 line Ducks & Crest on the snow  
6<sup>th</sup> a fine Day Drove a couple of Grad snow left  
Went to Head of the Island 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday Blowing  
hard not Cold 8<sup>th</sup> Tim Hopkins Charke and Billy Bone  
here 11 was down at Charles's saw get no Fire  
Mendoloh and I set the Deck's down at the  
tent near Bidmunks Bay fine Day 9<sup>th</sup> Ed  
Saw Chopping and sawing Stone Wood 10<sup>th</sup> Land  
Birth Day 1872 a fine Day Working at pulling up  
the Rellion Boards on the Wall not very well  
11<sup>th</sup> Cutting up a Peck that fell with the Wind  
Bag with a frame left in good Sea C of shooting  
up the way of the Hog Island 12<sup>th</sup> Drove home Day  
and 2 Loads of Logs of Beech some last my Rifa and  
found it 14 being stems in the Pipe of Pezang  
found to night 15<sup>th</sup> a fine morning East Wind New-  
Moon a Scotch moon that comes on Saturday  
in general a Rough moon that comes on on  
Saturday being a Rethel of Ben took wall Day  
and changed to West Blowing hard some fine  
Barn 17 Pezang same to night the cattle feeding  
at in the Day time
