I was Shelling Seed corn the fore part of the  
day. John was plowing

Sat May 17<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. I was ditching in  
lane. the boys harrowing corn ground. Anne  
about the same.

Sun May 18<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. Boglan  
Mead and his wife was here and  
Mary. Ann Mead & Mrs Cameron to see  
Anne. She is no better

Mon May 19<sup>th</sup> flying clouds and showers  
to day. John was marking out corn  
ground. Walter and I commenced plan-  
ting corn & potatoes

Tue May 20<sup>th</sup> cloudy. heavy rain last night  
the ground to wet to work this fore noon. the  
fore part of the day I was cutting potatoes and  
cleaning up oats. after noon planting potatoes.  
John marking out corn ground

Wed May 21<sup>st</sup> clear and hot. was planting  
corn John finished marking

Thu May 22<sup>nd</sup> cloudy. we finished planting  
this fore noon after noon making a pen  
for washing sheep. Anne no better.
