We fixed spreader and spread 11 loads manure on No 12nd from barnyard 3 horses. 4 AM 7 P.M. Willie drove down brought up Mary afternoon she went collecting for B.S. Miss Daly went with her. Harry Armstrong called for me at night we drove over to U.F.O. meeting at Shanks school house Dordund com.

7 fine sunny day thawing frost last night. Peter Clark up AM helped me bring small load hay from other barn on sleigh. Willie took 12 bags pig chop to mill 57 cts got 12 900 lbs white dust @ \$1.35 gave cheque on R.B. 12:15 got bread at Fosters 12 cts belt at Russell's rubber from N Smith 20 cts C.O.D 30 feet long at 25 cts for foot \$7.50 C.O.D express 62 cts total \$8.12 P.M. he drove Mary around by Roxburgs Byes etc collecting for B.S. Mary went home. Peter Clark came up again PM I helped him put load wood from bush on waggon he took it down to his place. We put new belt on chaffer and chaffed some corn.

Bella and I drove down at night etc
