men ploughed a.m. Douglas hoed garden, cut & wheat & shocked in p.m. Della picked berries, & I did up 6 qts. Newton & Dorothy cleaned cook stove to-day.
Thurs July 28
up at night for a while.

Weather - Partly cloudy - with light showers at evening.
men shocked wheat all day. Douglas ploughed sweet Elvies land - Mother, Gillie & I, went over to Auntie's for an hr or so in p.m. the girls stayed at Jeans & I called for them, Dorothy come up for tea Newton & Laura called in after supper.

Frid July 29
Weather - fair & cool
men ploughed all day. Katie Craig & Laura here for tea Douglas & Marion took them home about 11 p.m. Produce - 70 1/2 doz eggs.
