Newton called for Della to go to J. Gardner.

Weather - Lovely cool day, hot sun. East wind.

Men busy thrashing wheat, boys here also Dorothy, she & Della went over to Muriel Stivers to visit for the afternoon, Mr J. D. Mills called at noon with Dorothy in policy, later with a present for her. Lewis & Muriel brought girls home at night, finished thrashing by 6:30, then they moved machine down.

Wed Aug 3rd

Lorne called in.

Weather - rained most of night & early a.m.

Norm & Doug B. took bales over & baled 8 tons straw for C. Cox. Douglas, Marion, Della, Babe & I left at 11 a.m. for city, returned at 5 p.m. called to see Laura. Mr W. Clark here just before we left. W.M.S. at Mrs Stivers.

Norm cut a field of mixed grain in a.m. Doug shocked D. They all went down home & thrashed all but 2 loads wheat, we picked berries in a.m. & did them up in p.m. also ironing, Boys & I did millings.

Weather - Quite warm S.W. wind. rained night.

Men finished thrashing at home shortly after dinner, then they came up brought tractor cut down a field grain & started another.

Della went down home after supper, Florence C. here at tea time.

We all went to Richmond Produce - 66 D.G. eggs.

Sat Aug 6

Weather - Quite warm.

men finished cutting large field mixed grain, Doug & Norm shocked, we cut front lawn in p.m. Mr Williams called after dinner 4 D.G. eggs (Mrs Robins) Phyllis, Georgina & Doris Walter went thru after dinner, Lorne over at night, also Mr & Mrs Dinna.

Sun Aug 7

Weather - rather cloudy with light showers then warm.

Norm went to Grand Valley, Douglas & Marion went to city saw Bill M. & visited at his Mother's day & I did millings, Lorne here for tea, then Babe & I went down home with him they went to Jim's Jim McCarthy called at noon.

Mon Aug 8

Weather - Partly fair, rained in p.m.

men cut grain & shocked, Billie cut hay. they ploughed out potatoes in p.m. We washed, ironed, picked berries, Irene, Laura, Miss Head, Dorothy came in the evening, did hair, & got tennis.
