Pain.—Pain is a variable symptom depending on the operation, and, to a great extent, on the patient. We believe that convalescence is more rapid and more satisfactory if morphine in sufficient quantities to alleviate pain be given during the afternoon and night of the day of the operation. In very few instances will any opiate be necessary after the first 24 hours.—*Balfour; Mayo Clinic. Med. Record.*
