24 Morning very cool Marion & myself went to gather berries on Lenders east of Bromholm we got 5 quarts The boys & M. put in 4 loads of hay in from barn Bird made the washing. I canned the berries

25 Rain to day

26 Showers all day

27 Went in morning to Jimmie B. house saw currents went in afternoon to pick them got  $\frac{1}{2}$  lb codfish 30 cts. 2 yds thin <sup>13</sup> hirting 43 put in two loads of hay

28 1 lb butter 18 cts. 2 brown 4 white sugar 33 51  
4 lb molasses. 16. Expect visitors put in 3 loads in morning in afternoon

29 J. L. Brown came this morning before breakfast we were all glad.  
Got 5 lb codfish 56 cts Jimmie not well  
Boys not working

30 A fine day and large congregation

31 Bird & I made a large washing  
Mrs Blacklock & Eliza called and will come and stay over night

Got 3 lbs butter 60-

Mouli. I thought would come in in June, but did not make an udder until the first of July. Then she began to dwindle down, two days ago I began to milk her, and I get about 1 qt of dirty milk, and we saw no calf, and never heard <sup>or</sup> a moo from her
