Fine day sunny in A.M. a little rain in P.M. Mr Faskin of Toronto preached in A.M. from pro 15:2. and in evening from pro. 20:20.

Monday

Fine sunny day windy. We finished thrashing this morning by 10 o'clock. The machine went up to Rogersons we gave dinner to Sam M<sup>r</sup>. Kee Fred Ford and Fred Hooper. Willie took 14 chickens (crop fattened) to Adam Armstrong 72 lbs @ 8 1/2 on off brought up Jim Fernal and Lon M<sup>r</sup>. Sean they putted back mangels in root house got tea here paid them 32 cts We worked at open ditch and pulled out some pine stumps. Sent letter to Q.A.C. re ditching 2

Cloudy with few drops rain in P.M. Willie plowed 906 4 hours in A.M. and I put up pig chop. In P.M. Willie took it down and came back dished in No. 1 then went down forest again from Curbis made 7 bags. Gashed down in boggy in P.M. got at Mennis more traps 5 with at Rosells 10
