Cloudy most day snowing considerable in P.M. and evening. We set overflow trough in A.M. brought up some clay from 1 ditch to put under it. Fred Armstrong up in A.M. gave bottle oil to Dan. In P.M. I went to Wm Taylor's funeral got more stuff from Fred Armstrong for Kate 26 cts graham flour at Cartons 15 cts raw oil Menis on fire. We brought over sleigh from Atholburn. Mand got sick at night I went down in cutter got oil for her and other stuff from Fred took dog cabbage to Cartons 50 got wheat from 25 dollars from 2 Abbeled Phillips 10 paid Ken on fire \$5.00 got for cabbage 50
