Slight frost last night very fine sunny day a little windy. Willie at Allans thrashing all day. Ross and Jim up all day we got in 8 loads turnips to-day. Father up in P.M. got tea here.

30

Sunday

Hard frost last night cold and sunny day. Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from Romans 12:2. and in evening from 1st Pet. 1:10, 11, and 18. Willie at home. Had cold.

31

Monday

Very hard frost last night ground frozen solid sunny day fine in P.M. Willie at Allans thrashing in A.M. Ross and Jim up all day we got in 12 loads turnips two teams going in P.M.

November 1

Tuesday

Very fine sunny day little if any frost last night Ross up all day. we got 5 loads turnips to root house and 3 loads trimmed ones to pit

Wednesday

Fine sunny Indian summer day. Ross and Jim up all day Willie and I pulled and trimmed, Ross and Jim hauled. We got 12 loads to pit and two loads home to barn. Paid Jim in fuel \$3.40 and Ross on aft \$1.60. Willie and girls went down to Hugh Guthrie meeting at night Speakers Guthrie Coloud McVrea and James Mc Mullan.
