

11 Boys finished ^{Aug 1892} glazing south of bush
A M P finished cutting Oats east of dam
B helped P D's thresh. A helped Flavin's
Pull Peas with Deyne & Henry took
Gayman & his sister to M Burkholder's
Pon. W. rain before day light clear today
very warm A M, fine & Cool P m
12 P cut Oats in root field about 3 acres
& field back of Orchard all except dividend
we pulled Peas with rake I helped shock
Oats most of the day Jess shock kelp &
pitch back Peas W. very fine & Cool
13 B helped Thomas's thresh we shocked Oats
till about 10⁰⁰ then I & J Henry & Jess
shank finished pulling Peas till noon
A finished shocking Oats then A & Henry
helped Jess draw in Peas at Flavin's
P cut some Oats below Orchard
W. very fine & Cool
Sunday 14 at home N B's & Aunt Lizzy
were here at noon H B Adeline & Susanne
went to Flavin's W. very fine & Cool
15 B helped R Milroy thresh I helped us
draw in Spring Wheat & 5 loads Peas out of
big field I finished cutting oats except some
lodged along creek west of Meeting house
W. pretty warm I went to Cedar Grove P m
& finished soe out shocks at Flavin's

16 B helped Johnny Reesor to thresh Flavin's
& Jesse helped us draw in 13 loads Peas
till supper then boys helped them draw in
his Spring Wheat & one load Oats W. warm
17 B went threshing in H's place he has ^{very} cold
P H & A & Henry drew in 3 loads Peas A m
Henry helped Flavin's P m other boys drew
3 loads Peas & one big load loose Oats
(Bonanza) P m. big field is all in snow
W. very very warm. I don't feel very well
18 P & B helped Flavin's thresh A M I & A
& Henry drew last of Peas out of root field
3 big loads then boys drew in Bonanza
Oats loose & shocked few Oats below
Orchard W. very very warm & sultry
19 shocked list of Oats drew dung away so
that we can build straw stack first
ready to thresh tomorrow B went threshing
H came home he has cough W. very fine. Cool
20 Had W Reesor's steamer, threshed Fall Wheat
about Bus. Spring Wheat Bus Mummy Peas
off big field about 1 bus & one load in the
west barn we did not thresh W. fine
pretty warm south wind
Sunday 21 all went to Meeting at Hebron
