Cloudy morning cleared off but cloudy at times a few drops rain in P.M. We got up 5 thousand hard bricks and 5 thousand soft bricks from T.J. Hean to-day Ross Milne & the Sons at car Belle and I here and Willie drove the loads 8 loads we had Pikes and Rows' waggons besides our own. Father up in P.M. brought up Elma & Gabe from home pasture Willie down town at night got things 15cts paid Ross \$1.75 We paid Sons 6.25

Mr Mitell preached in A.M. from Acts The disciples were first called Christians at Antioch he read citation from Presby. re Mr McVicar's resignation notifying congregation to appear at meeting of Presby. in our church on 30th (Sunday) Mr McVicar of Belwood preached in evening from the sacrifice of Jethro's daughter.

Raining last night and this morning cleared off some but rained a few drops in P.M. We got hay fork put up etc in A.M. Willie cut some more hay No 7 in P.M. then went over to Wilsons with Fanny. Ross Milne up in P.M. We had mangels and potatoes also finished haying corn. Mr Sons got load of Nellie and sufferer in P.M. Willie got 11 sections from J. Chapman last week 70cts
