Cloudy morning cleared off but cloudy at times a few drops rain in PM. We got off 5 thousand hard bricks and 3 thousand soft bricks from T J H car to-day Ross Milne & Mr. Sars at car Billie and I hove and Willie drove the loads 8 loads we had Pick's and Rowes' waggons besides our own. Father up in PM brought up Elma & wife from home pasture Willie down town at night got things 15cts paid Ross \$1.75 - We paid Sars 6.25.

Fine in AM cloudy PM rained a little. warm. Mr. Mitchell preached in AM from Acts. The deacons were first called Christians at Antioch he read a letter from Presbytery re Mr. McVans resignation notifying congregation to appear at meeting of Presbytery in our church on 30th (Tuesday) Mr. Mcintosh of Belwood preached in evening from the sacrifice of Jethro's daughter.

Ross Milne up in PM We had mangels and potatoes also finished hoing corn. Mr. Sars got load of Hellie and sappler in PM. Willie got 11 scissins from J Chapman last week 7cts
