so stormy. Two young men & two girls stopped at our place about 8.30 p.m. as the horse was tired out. Mama came home this p.m.

Feb. 15. - Mon. - We washed for Elsie this morning & Hyne came out for me this afternoon. Elsie was some better.

Feb. 16. - Tues. - It is still storming & drifting but cleared up in the night. I went over to Mr. Dawson's & phoned out home.
