Bertha Robinson & Hattie called in the evening
Thur 27 hot on the sun but a nice cool west
wind - Marjorie baked bread & visited Hattie
& Bertha called in the afternoon & stayed a
long time. Two young people drowned night
before last at Montross
Friday 28 cold & foggy in the morning Marjorie
went to Beech's fell like a storm all day
& high wind. at night it lightened all
around but did not storm. Hattie stayed
all night. Paul went to Chippawa in the
forenoon & did the trading got a letter from
Mrs Pound. took 6 lbs of butter 2 lbs. 111. qt. 88 cts
worth of goods & had dinner 28 - got 5
Sugar 25 tea 25 coffee 13. Lard 10. Sugar 10
cheese 23 after dinner Paul went to George Hegames
by work & I had all the work to do at night

I churned in the forenoon after dinner baked
Lager cake, another cake, & cookies & two pies
at night - I put clean paper on some of the
shelves.
Sat 29. Hattie & Paul went to Chippawa she went on
to Drummondville to get her teeth fixed. Paul went after
Mrs Pound. I swept both rooms & scrubbed everywhere
there was an carpet & the steps & Parliament house got
everything done when they came at noon he went to
George Hegames got a dollar for both half days
Paul killed the long tailed hen that went to the other
house. Marjorie home about 2 o'clock. they found the
two bodies at Montross. Terrible thunder storm on
the after part of the night - Mrs Pound got up & came
in work at
Sun 30. Well day & set in the drizzle towards night
Hattie for tea. Mrs from here went to church
Mon 31 nice cool wind from the north east. we
had new potatoes & peas for dinner & cornstarch
padding. I churned. Paul drawing up apple
limbs of apple tree in pasture Marjorie took
Mrs Pound to Chippawa Archie helping
Riesinger check on the after noon
