appointed, as Mother, Marion, Roy, Jean & Girls & Laura came up for a short  
while, Mary & Ewen called in near tea time & Dorothy came up for tea.  
Come over after supper, G. Brown called in for Dorothy. Pat planted Herb  
4 flox & 2 or poppy.

Sun May 15  
Weather - Beautiful warm day & a wonderful night.

Newton brought Mother, Marion & Roy up for dinner. Della went down  
to Dick & Mother rode down with Norm to church, Billy & Norm did chores  
they went to Y.P.S. after supper, Marion & I were here alone for evening  
until E. Brown, Irene, Della, came in, then Newton & Laura called & took  
Roy & Marion down home.

Weather - warm a.m. quite windy in p.m. light showers.
