E.P. Mayflowers 4<sup>th</sup> sunned in heat

Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> fair

We cleaned up grain in  
morning and went to mill  
14 bgs mixed wheat oats & barley  
& brought back another gist  
got oil salt \$1.20 got 590 corn  
from Jim. got groceries  
Mr. J. Morris & family  
spent the evening with  
us. very pleasantly.

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> fine

We did chores and went for  
seed peas to Station  
pd. Freight \$1.38 then hauled  
five loads of turnips. 138

Friday 10<sup>th</sup> fine

We hauled two loads of  
turnips in morning &  
one in afternoon I went  
mother & I M.E. & Bessie went  
up to uncle Tom's
