Sunday 30th
Tuesday 5th fine
I went to Toronto early
in morning and found
all well and getting along
fairly well. we showed
bals and got 1st for 2 yr old
1st & 2nd for Yearling 3rd
for ball calf. & went to
M^{rs} Snells for tea and
stayed all night near there
pd for lodging. 50
Wednesday 6th fine
we showed bal today we
got 1st & 3rd for Cow 2nd
for 2 yr heifer. 1st & 3rd
for Yearling & 1st & 3rd for
heifer calf. 2nd for calf
herd & 2nd for aged herd
I sold a ram to Mr Thompson
of B.C. & I got home about
six 30 p.m. Meal tickets \$1.⁰⁰
Thursday 7th fine
I trimmed & shipped ram
for Mr Mercer to take to B.C.
and got hardware \$2.¹⁰. P &
