The Heart in Syphilis—No. 3.

The special method of treatment should be individual, but both mercury and salvarsan are efficacious in the condition; usually they are preferably combined; in some instances the former, in others the latter, acts best. Iodine is an efficient adjuvant in at least some instances.

Treatment should be continued until a permanent negative Wassermann is attained. Subsequent to this the management of the case should be along circulatory, not luetic, lines.
