- 6. Fine mild day. not a particle of snow although it looked like it

- 7. Very fine and mild in morning. He went to Lancaster on his wheel. Began to rain at noon was showery until midnight

Billie for Kate 1.35. Jimmie Brown wheeled from Lancaster. The oldest inhabitant does not remember such a fine winter it is not good for trade whelms is not good for heavy loads. and it is cold rising high 1.35

- 10. Some rain last night. and some today. About 10 A. M. turned bright and windy. To 3/4 lb butter 41 71
1 lb tea 30 Maryn went with Birdie Dingwall brook Miss McNaughton to Jimmie Dingwall's Kings road to spend the evening 30

- 12. There was snow this morning. It began to fall last night about 6 o'clock. it did not drift much. Murdy went to meet Far to Lancaster. was 2.40. P. M. Fine and bright. Far came by D. R. man

sugar 25. Murdy got there in morning. I got at M Crommons 2 yds red cloth 45 25
1/2 gill molasses 25. Looks like snow 1.50 25
- 14. Fine day. snow enough to make light sleighing

- 15. Girls talking for social tonight. Marion sent to Simpsons Toronto on Saturday for silk to make a waist for herself and Birdie sent \$3.00 postage & post. order sets 3. 4
- 16. Had a good social last night. 74 75

- 17. Cold day. Far went to Alexandria to agricultural meeting. To 1 gill coal oil 23 23
2 lbs butter 45 45
- 18. Fine day

- 20. Rain. I went to Humans. Got 3 lbs butter 40. 60
2 yds milk 10 paid 10
- 21. Slippery roads. very few in church My Sunday off 8 8
- 22. Fine and mild mercury up to 39
- 23. Cold this morning sleighing all off
