

February 5th 1892.

- Fri. 5. Lovely winter's day, cold, and clear all day, moonlight to night.
- Sat. 6. Very cold, 20° below zero, fine and clear during the forenoon, afternoon cloudy and very light snow fall, cloudy to night Mr. Hooper very sick, did not come to night.
- Sun. 7. Cold and cloudy, Gusto Kullise and I drove out to Alfreds, Brown commenced snowing just after we arrived, about eleven O'Clock and continued till about five O'Clock, wind shifting from the east, and turning milder Mrs Warner came home today
- Mon. 8. Mild, almost again all day, at present it is snowing Emma Warner, gone home today

February 9th 1892.

- Tue. 9. A light fall of snow early in the morning, clearing off and being very lovely in the evening, I spent at Mr John McCaul's
- Wed. 10. Lovely all day, clouding over at night, with the appearance of snow,
- Thu. 11. Snowing all day from the east clearing a little in the evening, again snowing all night,
- Fri. 12. Stopped snowing, fall of snow about 4 inches, clearing off at about 8 O'Clock, cold and clear, all day clouding over at night with a light fall of snow, clearing again and turning very cold
- Sat. 13. Very cold and clear sun very bright Thermometer 18° below zero, but getting considerable latter in the day, brilliant weather Lights very
