 June 1 G Plowed down dung then we sowed
 feed Corn in double rows at least 2 rows
 This evening W. fine warm
 2 I & G Pulled Red-com weed in new Meadow A.M. I
 & John & Flaming went fishing to dead water of source
 P.M. Caught fine mess among them was a large eel
 Sunday 3 at home all day Baby has measles. W. warm
 4 I went to Monkham A.M. & to Cherry wood P.M. W. clear
 5 drew Cedar log to P.M. A.M. harrowed turnip ground
 & warmed hands to work on road next Tuesday
 6 I & B. C. & Moyer went trolling to G mens bay
 not good weather. Caught 7 G Punch Thistles
 7 I took Oats to Mill then helped G Punch Thistles
 8 I & B. C. Kitcher Colt went well I & G punched
 Thistles till supper then sang Pigs & found fence
 along bush & brought home Chop. W. very warm
 9 Punched Thistles. W. slight shower this evening
 Sunday 10 all went to Meeting at Cedar Grove
 Mathe Cook was here last night she went to
 Meeting with us remarks by P. D. Hoover
 Sumner on by B. C. went to B. D.
 P.M. W. very Cool for the season
 11 drew dung on fallow I helped to fill
 12 had all hands drawing gravel on Pickering
 townline G drew dung on fallow W. Shows P.M.
 13 worked on road G drew dung W. Showers went
 14 finished drawing dung on fallow G began plowing & I
 began plowing turnip ground W. pretty warm
 15 I finished turnip ground G Plowed in fallow W. warm
 16 had a bee drawing gravel on Pickering townline 4 teams
 W. clear warm all the morning cool wind came

June 17 went to Meeting at Hebron little
 Abram & Ether are getting better of Measles
 Benjamin staid at home with them by P. D. Hoover
 by B. C. Sumner on
 18 I & Nancy went to Monkham & to G H
 Rancis I collected turnip ground after
 we came home G Plowed. W. very warm
 19 I made turnip drills G Plowed I went
 to Cherry wood this evening W. Cool
 20 I sowed turnip A.M. Scuffled early Potatoes
 P.M. then went for Dr. Robinson. little Abram
 is sick G finished plowing fallow W. Cool
 21 helped to wait on Abram he has inflammation
 on liver & lungs. W. rainy fine heavy showers
 22 G harrowed fallow & hatched feed Corn W
 23 I & G helped to dig out foundation for
 new Meeting house we intend to move it north
 into new shed yard W. fine Abram some better
 Sunday 24 at home all day Moyer's girls & B. C.
 Mary were here. W. fine. Abram doing pretty well
 25 I & G took 18 bus gabst wheat to Cedar Grove & 6 2 bu
 for sale at \$1.50 per bus it was \$2.05 a while ago
 then G drew dung on fallow W. fine
 26 G drew dung on pile above dam A.M. both
 helped draw stones for wall under meeting
 house P.M. there were 10 teams & 2 drew sand
 W. Showers P.M.
 27 G drew dung with 2 waggons I maintained
 filled W. fine Abram getting better slowly
 28 G drew dung A.M. went away with his
 Brother & Father W. fine Showers P.M.
 29 G Chopped. I was away. W. soaking rain P.M.
 30 I & Nancy went to Whitevale A.M. cut up
 edgings & hatched a little then went home early not well
 W. warm clear heavy hail storm through Desboro
 yesterday. destroyed grain badly
