a fortunate Day Fine cool Windy a few
grains of snow fell Thrashing the Beans
Got Papers and Pictures of the Duke and
Duchess of York from Dan St Luke Day
Randolph here for his Roles Fernandez and
him went to Lancaster for his gun the men
of the Dredge here took 28 lbs of Butter and
4 doz of Eggs 12 Butter 6.12 Paid all up to
this date the Dredge moved off from here
to night Rained to night 19th Raining
Stanley Ploughing in forenoon Leander not
well and Rained to night Windy 20th Rain
Eddy Kershaw and Gordon here Rain
to night Livinia & Sissy, Tom Leander all
Bad with Grip or cold coughing Bad
Heard Ambrose Dunn's Wife Departed
yesterday Fernandez at So Douquette 20th
Fine Stanley Ploughing Leander fixing
Blinds Fernandez came putting a blind
out here I am splitting stove wood
Feeding corn to the pigs Frost and ice
Last night 21st Fortunate Day
22nd Fine Windy took over the Potatoes
from the other House about 70
Bushels in the cellar all good
Stanley Ploughing split some stove
wood Alexander went down the
Dredge went down yesterday
Fernandez to Summerstown took of Flour
and Ginger 23rd Livinia (Sissy) Birth Day

3 Butter tubs East Wind high to night
Finished the chimney Eddy and Adelaide

Shooting 29th Fine & Wind Lots of Shooting
to Day Stanley ploughing got a Surgeon
Cutting the stove pipe holes Drew up
my Bun in the Grove set 3 Lines
30th very Fine Stanley Ploughing on the lower Point
Eddy here Making Blinds to Day took over
the stove and pipes Fernandez crossed to Summer
town took a Crock for Butter for Adelaide
Fernandez went across again got some Surgeon
John H took old decoy top Spink 3 Boat Clogs
one of them sea Boat
