Fine bright and warm a perfect day, no need of a coat, I was at morning church, for a walk with Mrs D. in afternoon not out in eve. 7.

Mon Sept 17.

Fine bright and warm, Mrs D. and I at B. Hiner's funeral, made blue Plumb jam, Mrs Davidson gave me a basket.

Tue Sept 18.

Fine bright a perfect day, I went to Toronto, called at W. Cooks and at Dr Campbells. eyes tested no change in glasses but eyes have a tired look more like from general health.

Wed Sept 18.

I got a basket of Peaches 85 cents, did them up in evening
