- Sun Oct 13. Dull then cleared and cooler. I went to morning church. Aunt Nellie in bed. Annie called. first. Aunt Mattie and I Meth. Church.
- Mon Oct 14 Thanksgiving day. we washed. Aunt Nellie in bed. Aunt Mattie and I at Mr Bows' funeral. Cold and windy. squalls.
- Tue Oct 15 Fine but very cool. and windy. I took up Dahlias.
- Wed Oct 16. Aunt Mattie took Snow apples to Aunt Lizzie's. we light Range first. Annie called in evening. Muck dug garden.
- Wed Oct 16. Fine but cool heavy frost. Aunt Mattie and I Prayer Meeting
- Thur Oct 17. Fine but cold wind. raked leaves. Annie & I at Major Dean's.
- Fri Oct 18. Dull and cold. Major Dean brought. feed. * 4.30. Butter ^{2 50}
- Sat Oct 19. Fine bright day. Mary Watson called. cleaned double windows
- Sun Oct 20. Raining heavily, first heavy rain for two weeks. we have had Range light every afternoon. Annie called in afternoon. no Church Service in Thornhill on account of Flu
- Mon Oct 21. Fine but cold wind. I walked to Willis for a while. in afternoon.
- Tue Oct 22. Fine and moderately warm. Mr and Mrs Breakey called in eve - Harry Parkinson put up Furnace pipes.
