came here about two o'clock & took me to
Brockville as a witness between him & J. W.
Cummings Cummings took Marchet for
breifings & damage for digging a small ditch
to let the water of his field. But J. W. says
it was 10 dollars damage & I signed for him
that I swore it was no damage
