I drilled up potato with scuffer then scuffled some turnips used Rhoda Willie used Punch and Luy in rake. won Clark eggs 2 doz 54 cts. I drove Mary down tonight to buy I took to 70 I 12 doz eggs at 2.00 3.12 got groceries \$1.45 from \$1.30 got at Simpsons chocolates 50 cts paid for Thomson afe funeral expenses \$107.00 by cheque on I. B. returned paper work to Chapman.
