It was a nice day I stacked grain at the new barn John Seymour helped me the harvest dinner was held at Inkerman The Threshing Machine moved to my place at night 1918 It was showery we in the morning we went up to Laura Wylie for dinner and up to Milton Ross for tea and on home

FRIDAY 30

(242-123)

It rained a little in the morning we threshed over at the new barn John Muckley and Misses and Ima called here in the afternoon 1918 It was quite nice I ploughed Fred went to Spencerill for Laura she was up to Burrickville to a convention Mrs Cook was back to see us

SATURDAY 31

(243-122)

It was fine day I cut some Oats in the morning and helped Edgar Luther thresh in the afternoon bef I It was a nice day Alvin Liegent was here for dinner the boys and Laura and I went to church and Sunday school 1918 It was a damp day we fanned up the rye Fred went to Spencerill and got some Ground Robert Kowely came out and stayed all night
