Alcohol Antidote.

Ammonium chloride is recommended as an antidote to alcohol, given in doses of 30 to 60 grains, with copious draughts of water to prevent gastrointestinal irritation. It prevents the effects of the alcohol, sobers the patient quickly, and is a valuable preventive against delirium tremens. Should the patient not become quiet after taking the remedy, bromide or chloral hydrate may be administered.—*Med. Times.*
