an order for two more's went down to Bank
dressed out \$4.00 went down paid \$1.00 duty
it was \$4.00 but Dan Britton owed me 10
cents
over me 3 cts got paid my dues in G.O.F.
up to 1st of Nov. \$3.30 Hicks drained the
granite up from station for me I
gave him \$1 Billy helped him with
two load about 2 hrs. he lettered McKeacher
fontstone I loaded McKeacher job on Gou-
-yon's waggon. Thos. Berry was in paid
for his man. \$3.50 have to night 39.70
I left after tea got out D. Billy's about ten
has been a nice day.
