 26th Went to the Mill put 1 1/2 of Pease got a
 Stave 1 Sucker cut the wheat down next the
 Barley turning the oats ^{at Sandy with all}
 Order to George ^{got a summer} ^{did not 27th}
 Charlie here had Cucumbers got the Pease of the
 Line put in the East of the Oats put in the subsoil
 1 load 28th cut some Marsh Hay Making the stone
 29th Raining Moving the Hoop pen Drew some
 stones to the River cut one of the chowes that was on
 the Bank of the River put in some Butter mits Sunday
 the 30th Sandy & Laurie cropped very high had a Horse
 Laurie & Sandy 31st Put in a load of Wheat & a load of
 Marsh hay in the stable took 2 Bushels of Pease out to
 Williamstown 1st of September got some drawers from
 her got some fat Pine on Big 8 and place cutting Marsh hay
 Fixing my ashes & iron for salmon ^{2nd} 2 lbs of Iron & 3 Bushels
 of Ashes Bought of Baker 3 bushels of lime at 1/9 got 30
 cents each 1 lb shot 1 Box caps 4 papers 4 cents Bought
 of Spruie 1/2 lb candles 1/6 crackers 5 cents 2 Buckets
 of Barley to Mill Gave Anna Nide Joan Thomas
 Annroe at Lakes John Cornbell Married on
 the 23rd of August 3rd Blocking the Western
 of the House giving the cord Wood shot a Duck
 Raining 4th cutting Marsh Hay Fishing Perch
 washing some of the corn put in the Pig the
 cattle on the inside of gate now opened a Board

Sunday Bob & Chara Bone here took in a
 Basket of hazelnuts sandy & 7th Fishing
 Perch Angus & Tom Darrs came had 4 traces
 and the scivered Dan commenced to
 Peach for the first turn out of his
 Life coring the Hay in the front Marsh
 coils put in 6 Before Sandy at the 8th
 Angus & Sandy cropped gave sandy 6
 cents Andrew Summers selling of his stone
 coring hay in the Back Marsh highland
 Sandy working at the ground for the fall wheat
 shot a Duck some one at the cord Wood Lashey
 went to Cornwall to fish at the stones
 9th putting out manure on the Pease for fall
 wheat 10th putting out manure 11th
 coring the hay in the Back Marsh 12th Thrashing
 2 of Big Pease Anturim Russell came home
 13th Sunday alone Wind high 14th Sand cropped
 to Summers Sandy starting putting out manure
 Anturim Trowling Christie here making a Bench
 Anturim set his line 15th commenced to plough
 spreading manure Anturim Thrashing Wheat high
 Wind very smoky with fires out 16th Ellen & Lis & Libe
 here for grapes Fanning 2 Bushels of heat 17th went
 to Mill Bought of Norman 1 Knife 1/10 1/2 Tobacco
 Matches 1/6 line 1/3 which comes to 4/10 1/2 Loan of Bottle
 Bought of R Buchanan 1/2 lb Tea 2/6 Took dinner at home
 Ellen came down with us 18th Raining Making spools
 about 70 19th cutting Hoop Poles about 100 Anturim
 Thrashing the Big Pease Sandy at a Pounder Sunday 20th
 Bill his wife & Mother Ab here Anturim Boule wife
 and sister here gave an oar to Abie got a Sturgeon
