Pepper 24th Fine finished cutting the oats
Began cutting the Barley Turning oats
Fishing got 18 2 men from the Pitt Point
got Chicken and corn Leander to Dundee
got 2 Butter Tubs East Wind some
Drops of Rain St Bartholomew's Day
1 Tub of Butter to Jo Dougherty 14 Doz of Eggs 7.8
a Man and Boy senting at head of the Island
