calm the ice would take but its too windy 3rd
Allen's Birth Day 1853 Fine Fair and Frosty
Ice Taken to Christmas this morning ice taken
to Little Island North Side Leander and Stanley
crossed to it ice going down making in some
Places if it keeps on freezing this way to night
you may cross tomorrow Taken across to Frasers Point
4th Leander and Stanley went up the ice Leander
crossed Lots of small holes got the Mail Fernandez
came Back with them snowed some Blustery freezing
hard to night went for Eels got 3 Bought Screws
5th a very Frosty Day Windy Fine Sun shining
Working at an outside Door for the Kitchen Fore
here Last night got a Blue Bill yesterday on the ice
Fernandez crossed got some of the Mail 6th Epiphany
Sunday Fine Randolph and I fink Fishing got
a very large Pike some Puck 3 Eels our Boys got
a Black Duck on at Little Island South Side Began
to snow a little East Wind not cold Randolph took
the Measuring Tape 7th Fine & Wind Snowing at
their axes ground 3 of them took the Black Duck
over to the other House Fernandez went to chop at
Mr Charles Craigs 8th Ann's Birth Day 1866
a very Fine Day East Wind cutting some of the
trees the Wind Blew Down I went over to the
old House Broke on a Marsh hay stack yesterday
Leander to Summerstown to night Rained hard to night
9th Fine not very well put out Bushes yesterday
to Hamittons Wharf Took over the Pork and Salted it
caught some Perch Snow all off the ice putting out
few seeds of Manure Windy to night 10th Wind Windy cold
Big East Wind Storm Snowing Drifting Blue Bill Dead
in some hall to night windy

James Cameron Island 11th of January 1901

Fine cool East Wind Fixed the cupboard in the 2nd
corner of the Kitchen Blowing snowing Drifting 12th
Old Style Drifting Snowing wind changed to West
Fernandez came about 2 o'clock snowing hard
to night and Drifting Frank Laplante crossed
the Summerstown Road on the ice with a Horse
on the 11th 13th Fine Dan's Sink and Randolph here
went Fishing Perch got 2 and Fishing Eels
got 40 lost the Spear the fish broke a
large latter Fernandez went with them to
Craig 14th Fine a lot of water coming for
Eels Fishing Drew 2 last of good took up a
barrel of water clear of Eels & Wind
15th Fine cool East Wind some Frosts of Fine Rain
Randolph here had a letter from Dan
and the Cornwall Standard 2nd South Head Sea
I went to night rained some 16th
Fine rained some showers Randolph here
Bought the Annasden gun him and Leander
Fishing Perch sun shining getting kind of
floppy 17th 8 Perch and 2 Eels some Windy
to night 17th Fine Day snowing came over to
Summerstown gave him a 2nd bottle to buy
Counound & travelling money 18th Perch
he molly went for Eels got 2 Eels to day
few Perch Sunday chance Frank Laplante a
Bee to Day 18th Fine a very Frosty Day Randolph
came Fernandez came had 2 Bottles of Strawberry
50 Envelopes 20 Blotting Paper 5 took Back 1.25
Pepper 10 Bought Pants overalls Shirt Bottle of Ink
Mrs Peter Chisholm in the Gore Buried
To Day Carlo not well wont Eat or Drink
very Frosty To night 19th Carlo Died very very
Frosty Day George came Making a Neck Yoke Fixed
the Pump Summerstown Road Bushed 18th
