

Obliged to return. Cut a few pieces of wood for the fire.
Tuesday 5th.

Strong wind and snowing. Ground some corn and cut a little
fire wood. Wednesday 6th.

Milder but snowing all day; fetched 4 bags of turnips home
cut fire wood. Thursday 7th.

Very cold and windy; cut some fire wood fetched some
turnips home. Friday 8th.

I come home this morning and went to Turners in the afternoon
and paid for the cow. Sleighted turnips home. Paid 20s.
Dollars for cow. Saturday 9th.

Gathering moss for stopping roof of house, strewing turnips
home, mild and thawing.

Sunday 10th.
Thawing with a light breeze.

Monday 11th.
Cold with flights of snow at intervals. Robert stopping roof
with moss. Phillip attending to the cow and oxen. Father
Fred grinding corn in morning. Father after tub on the
stone in the afternoon. Boiling Pumpkins went to
needy's store fetched 1 gallon of oil and two pairs of boots
3d. per pair oil 2d. did not pay. Settled with
Turner for 11 pounds of tallow a 5d per lb. and 4 3 lbs. of
at 5d. 1. 2. 6d. left 6d. due me. Emptied privy, chopped
fire wood. Tuesday 12th.

Boiling pumpkins, cutting fire wood, cutting logs for
cellar, grinding wheat, stopping roof of house with moss.
Morning cold with flights of snow finer in the afternoon.
Wednesday 13th.

Boiling pumpkins, cutting logs, getting bush into ox shed
Bought Buck saw of John Goble 3. 5d. Fine frame on saw
5 shilling sold to ditto one Butchers knife and 6 awls.
Settled with Mrs Goble for washing and cooking 11s. 3d.
due Iden Goble 1 Dollar and 1/2 and 8d. mending shoes &c.
Thursday 14th.

Getting logs for fire wood, Boiling pumpkins, underbanding
fine and day preceded by slight frost.
Friday 15th.

Mild cloudy day; Boiling pumpkins, underbanding, signed
petition for a division of Lagen into wards. Cash in
hand 30s 12s 1 1/2d. I have not yet made out the account
of money expended on journey.
