M.'s meeting she gave her essay on Raymond Lull. she gave roll 10¢ got at F. & S. oatmeal 10¢ at Fords bread 18¢ I got hinges at Menries 25¢ on dp. Mary got goods at Russells on dp. Willie took cow No 1 over to Wilsons P.M. bred. then plowed west fence sand hill single plow.
