2 Dollars to Day shot a Drake
Gordon came had the Mail got
a Letter from D. M. M.

of Mr 3.70 100 of Flour 2 Tea 3lb 1
Dollar Pair of Pants Shot
got 5 Dol on the Pigs sold 1
of the young Pigs Bill to get
one Mr Gene came
to night had his Stone
Lifter and its Rigging a Pair
of Boots for Stanley 1.25, 3 Subs
