Trees in the Grove 24<sup>th</sup> Fine & Wind  
high Went to head of the Island

Gathered nuts Seander and Stanley  
At the nuts Stanley drew them  
home with the horse Seander

crossed to P. O Took the Letter  
I wrote to Dan it went to tell

Monday Fernandez came to night a Fern  
with 12 Fine Chicks came out to Dan  
Gordon came with Seander
