Frost last night a little ice on water sunny day cool. We bring rest of flax and put in on waggon and put load we took in Sunday I took it to Alma 1 1/2 tons got \$10 per ton \$15.00. Willie wore some more fuel. Mary went up to Skunks in PM took mother with her who was up here (Belmond road) she got at Wells meat 40 at Amstutz oatmeal 10 Russell dress goods 14. from Oakes for butter 38 gave to mother

Friday

Looked like rain cloudy in morning. not so cool. Willie at May woods and Picks thrashing all day. I brought in rest of flax loose and bound stuff mixed harrowed the plowed land of No 1 twice then put load corn on each waggon. Some one took our little gate last night Mary and Bella down town in PM got at Woods goods 93 paid apr July 24 balance 198 at Steels dress goods 70 and goods on apr \$125 at Phillips under 25 put card 5

Some rain last night warm day sunny and cloudy some rain at night. Willie at Picks thrashing in morning and at Albus rest of day. I took in corn to orchard fixed fence etc. Mary down town in AM got at Menis paint 40 at Steels good 18 at Foots tea 40 sold to Foot 2 doz eggs 36. I went down town at night got at Menis paint 40<sup>pt</sup> at Foots bread 5 paid James Calder watch cleaning 75. Willie found little gate in Mrs Durns. paid Thompson picture moulding \$1.00
