Fine sunny day warm. I thinned two rows turnips Willie rolled up 202. May down town in A.M. got at Phillips 2 lbs Paris 75. Lamp 2 boxes 5. die oil 10. Rubber rings 5. got butter 1.78 at Pattersons drop goods 5.5. Father up in P.M. we tried to get sprayer to work but failed hence put Paris green on about 1/3 of potatoes with cans we got in hay cut in orchard 2 loads Mr Guss over in P.M. had his row of potatoes and put Paris green. Willie drove father and I down in evening with Jess in dd boys just got home before an auto came down road.
