 Charles here going to Carey's Strawberries
 Ripe some more for Anne Mary Leona
 and me at the Lower Point for Berries 15th
 I went to Brundee Boughty Buchanan 1 1/2
 of Potatoes at 2/6 per Bushel 3/8 Hood 8 1/2 bush
 Oats at 40 cents for 34 lb Bought 1/4 of soap at
 a lb Bought Mudding dish 30 cents I owe him 16 cents
 on this Returned Baker's Bag steep at 10
 Morn'g with the shower stop at Alex Island
 till the storm was over Charles brought some
 plants 2 men here for Borush Timber
 did not get any 20th Tom came from Best
 Mary Moccasin 21st Lowest day in the year got
 2 perch at the line 18 hooks on Lashy came stop
 all night got 2 eels from him 22nd Our Lord
 Birth day being some fixing the Gate got a Pick
 24th Perch Mosquitoes Bait 23rd Charles here set
 his shirt to make Baited the line with chub Charles being
 Lashy here at night 24th Antoine Russell fishing else
 Tom started turned back with the wind 25th a fortunate day
 Sunday got 2 eels got 1 large Pike thunder & lightning
 31st at night Morn'g some strawberries now put the lower part
 26th Morn'g planting the Potatoes & Corn Raining very dirty
 with the Potatoes 27th Wind High high 28th Wind
 at the Potatoes Below the house 28th Charles came
 Pat & I made some and sent a Bag & Bottle to
 Post at the Potatoes and at the Weeding & Watering
 the Garden heard of three that was killed on the Road
 sochatty Cunningham every day for John raising his
 29th Morn'g working on the Road more & Summers performed
 on selling liquor 30th Wind high putting the Plough through
 to most of the Potatoes before the Snow broke the Plough

 not paid 1/3 to the Sea paid 3 cents paid
 Laying of the Foundation stone of
 Cameron's house laid a great ceremony
 6th Cropped with Charles and Pat 15
 of sea Carpet 3 1/2 yds of 1 kind 4 yds of
 at 1/2 that 7/6 not paid Bought 1 lb of
 1/2 doz of Bread 1/3 copperas for sheep
 1/2 paid this went to Munschaw for
 of Sugar for the Harper Pat and
 Thomas Murre's Charles and I became a fine
 7th Day started turned back started again
 8th Hoing some Christie here grinding he
 Tim a tree for spear pole put out 10
 of Tobacco yesterday got 2 eels 1 sturgeon
 from Lashy went to his line with
 the hope of the St Charles a Race 3
 Raspberries getting Ripe at new 10th
 Tom Hopkins to W. Elphinstown
 and his family 5th Jan Family
 here coming back on the Bush Ford
 Mary & Leona I picking 13 eels
 10th Finished hoing Below the house first
 wishful wind
