Syphilo-Dermo-Urologic Aphorisms.

The accurate determination of a syphilitic roseola is, at times, a difficult matter for an inexperienced hand to diagnose. In such a case the erythematous macules, produced by the bites of insects, closely simulate the specific eruption and a little attention will enable anyone to easily differentiate the two. Subjectively, the insect-bite itches, the leucic eruption does not; objectively, the former has a bright scarlet punctum near the center, the latter does not. Naturally concomitant symptoms of syphilis will aid in corroborating the diagnosis.—*Amer. Journ. of Derm.*
