(rained heavy last night) windy Willie took pig chop 3 1/2 lbs horse and brown chop to Wilsons AM got paint at Maries aft 50cts brought up Mrs Folger's son whose husband is hired at Day Adams for a year the family living in half the house. In PM Willie took load turnips down to Beattie 73 bushels more and brought up the chop \$1.10 We are taking the turnips from barn floor and trimming them as they are harvested stock price 15cts.
